Several political personalities already call for Macron to vote in the second round.

WINNERS ARE EMMANUEL MACRON AND MARINE LE PEN FIRST RESULTS OF ELECTION OF 1st ROUND

At 8 pm, the first provisional estimates are to be broadcast, one hour after the closure of the last polling stations in mainland France. According to the results published by Harris Interactive with M6TV, In France, the law specifically prohibits any publication of anticipated results before this time so as not to influence voters. Compared to 2012, the Parliament has moreover complicated the task by pushing back these closures from 18 to 19h (or even 20h in large cities).-----

But these estimates - which are based on actual ballot papers - risk this year to retain some uncertainty about the traditional poster of the two qualified candidates, if scores are tight. They will however be updated gradually in the evening, according to the count.
