PRESIDENT MACRON HELD A SOBER & SOLEMN PASS OVER CEREMONY FOR HIS REELECTION

450 GUESTS AT ELYSEE ON MAY 7

He has repeatedly insisted on his future governance by "Acting to make our country a stronger agricultural, industrial, scientific and creative power by simplifying our rules and investing for this France of 2030, and Act to continue to build progress for everyone and work for equality between women and men » President Macron said. "And at the end of the speech President Macron recalled that he will be devoted, during the next five years, to France to serve its people "To serve our country, a miracle of the will and freedom of men. To serve our fellow citizens whose sense of duty and love of country are our surest assets. To serve our children and our youth to whom my thoughts go at this moment and to whom I swear to bequeath a more livable planet and a more lively and more strong."

" The real difference between the inauguration of 2017 and that of 2022 lies in the attitude of President Macron, who appeared more detached, displaying rather a modesty, golden appearances of power, by not wearing the gold necklace of the Legion of Honor. He thus displayed rather a modesty and seemed very moved, and certainly aware that this new mandate will require acting with more empathy towards the French people, thus citing human rights "He is also aware that the current context of the war in Ukraine, the day before May 8, the date marking the victory of the allies over the Nazis during the Second World War. It is thus, through sobriety and humiliation that President Macron marked his new investiture to stand out from that of 2017, to announce a renewal of his next five-year term. President Macron greeted his guests from the 1st row, before greeting the military troops (Army, Navy, etc.) in the gardens of the Elysee Palace. In accordance with the tradition, inherited from the Middle Ages, 21 cannon shots, were titled from the Invalides, to announce the official mandate of the President of the Republic Macron, elected, on April 24 from May 14, 2022 at zero hours and one second, for five years of reign.

The ceremony started at 11 a.m., with the proclamation of the result of the vote of April 24, declaimed by the President of the Constitutional Council, Mr Laurent Fabius, facing President Macron, surrounded by 450 guests, and including all members of the government and their PM Jean Castex, as well as ex-President Nicolas Sarkozy and Francois Hollande and three ex-PMs, Edouard Philippe, Jean Pierre Raffarin, & Manuel Valls, President of the National Assembly Richard Ferrand and President of the Senate Gerard Larcher.

Immediately afterwards, General Puga of the Legion of Honor made the ceremonial announcement consisting of offering the necklace of the Legion of Honor, 950g, made of gold and comprising 16 links bearing the names of the Presidents of the previous republics. It is a historic offering and marks the "transfer of power"

President Macron then signed a book...before making his comment, in front of an audience made up of official guests, civil society and friends, and relatives, standing up, in this magnificent renovated holiday home, under his mandate.

Actors of the Prestigious Comédie Française, created in 1680, by King Louis XIV, including Guillaume Galliene (Four Cesar Awards,

and Two Moliere Awards) and Christophe Heck (Nominated Moliere Award 2022) Jean pierre Dumontet (CEO of JMD Prod, Largest Production Company for Theater and TV Shows, Owner of Many theaters in Paris Théâtre Antoine, le Théâtre Libre, Le Point-Virgule, Le Grand Point-Virgule, Bobino, le Sentier des Halles.), Francois Cluzet (Six Cinema Awards, Actor of the Film "Intouchables"), Bernard Montiel, (TV and radio host), Billionaire Xavier Niel (CEO of Illiad Group Free Mobile and Mediawan), as well as his wife Delphine (Daughter of Bernard Arnault, CEO of LVMH), Tony Parker, the basketball champion, were aligned alongside the sister and sister-in-law of Brigitte Macron. Most of these guests from the world of Culture in France are personal friends of the Macron couple, who are very passionate about theatre. On the side of the family, the sister of Brigitte Macron, as well as her sister-in-law Brigitte Trognes, were also present, installed in the Front row.

THE INVESTITURE CEREMONY WAS VERY SOBERLY CELEBRATED ACCORDING TO THE REPUBLICAN RITUAL IN THE FESTIVITY HALL OF ELYSEE PALACE

After the proclamation of the results of the number of people who voted for Emmanuel Macron, 18,678,639 and the winning designer of this Presidential election 2022 (He had won 58% of the universal suffrage against Marine Le Pen, April 24, 2022) by Laurent Fabius, President of the Constitutional Council, the re-elected President of the Republic, passes to the second stage of his investiture. He receives the collar of Grand Master of the Order of the Legion of Honor, with the phrase, again ritual, pronounced by General Puga, Grand Chancellor of the School of the Legion of Honor: "We recognize you as Grand Master of the Order of the Legion of Honor." In 2017, during his first inauguration, President Macron, before wearing the gold necklace, weighing 950g, of the Legion of Honor and gave a long speech. This time, Emmanuel Macron having become "double President" did not wish to wear the necklace of the Legion of Honor. He also opted for a shorter, intense and hard-hitting speech, while he appeared more physically changed as he matured in five years, from 39 to 44. President Macron then signs a guest book, before delivering his speech, behind the desk installed nearby.

PRES. MACRON SALUTE MILITARY TROOPS DETACHMENTS AND TRIBUTE TO SOLDIERS KILLED IN COMBAT

After delivering his speech, President Macron went to the Elysée garden to hear the firing of the traditional 21 cannon shots, fired from the Invalides, from where he held the honor to the flag. tricolor, under the song of La Marseillaise, the French national anthem and mark his review of the troops, greetings to the grieving unit leaders, knowing that he wished the presence of elements of the Foreign Legion in this section of the 'Land Force. Patient presents, a detachment of the 1st Marine Infantry Parachute Regiment, which is one of the special forces army regiments, very involved in the fight against terrorism, particularly in the Sahel. After having reviewed the bagad and the music of the Republican Guard which will have played the Marseillaise, he will review a section of the Republican Guard, that is to say the formation which honors the President of the Republic, in particular in the Élysée Palace, then a section of the army.

THE MONGE BUILDING WITNESS THAT FRANCE IS A DETERRENT NUCLEAR POWER------

The detachment of the navy, which was reviewed, is made up of elements of the test building and Measure Monge, it is a building of the Naval Action Force which has two characteristics. The first is that it's a big boat based in Brest, which has an extremely important role in preparing for the future and preparing, in particular for nuclear deterrence. It is equipped with very large tracking radars and is used for testing and maintaining the qualifications of our nuclear deterrent. And it has the particularity of being a navy boat, but which carries experts from the General Delegation for Armaments. That is to say, the internal structure of the Ministry of the Armed Forces, the internal military structure of the Ministry of the Armed Forces which makes the link between industry and operational needs. There will also be an element of the Hubert commando, the Hubert commando, it is one of the 5 assault commandos of the French Navy. It is the commando of combat swimmers Le Monge, represents France is a nuclear power and has been implementing deterrence since the 1970s. And that, therefore, pre-exists the Ukrainian and Ukrainian crisis and France will be a nuclear power after the Ukrainian crisis. So simply deterrence is an essential component of our defense policy and we don't hide it, that's it. Therefore, Monge contributes significantly to the construction and maintenance of this strategic function which makes France the country which can speak as it speaks in the concert of nations. In the tradition, the President of the Republic has requested the presence of a certain number of specific military formations to greet them in the garden of the Elysee. For example, his movement is consistent with military ceremonies, that is to say that after going out on the steps and on the terrace, the President of the Republic went in front of the Standard to be honored. This gesture means that the Standard pays the honors to the President of the Republic, that is to say to the elected representative of the French people. And at the end of this republican ritual of military honor which includes the Banner and the Marseillaise.

President Macron, reviewing to the sound of the music of Bagad de Lann-Bihoue, playing a piece called "Between land and sea" and he explicitly requested this piece "Between land and sea", played by Bagad because it is a piece that in particular marked a number of national tributes, in particular the national tribute that had been paid to master Cedric De Pierrepont and Alain Bertoncello, who were marine commandos who had been killed during a hostage release operation in 2019. AIR FORCE MILITARY DETACHMENT SYMBOLIZES "THE NEW SPACE OF CONFLICTUALITY"-------

The air force detachment present is made up of elements of the space command. The space command is the structure that was created under the impetus of the President of the Republic to take into account this new space of conflict. It is therefore the product of the decisions that were taken at the beginning of the previous five-year term to prepare our armies and our nation for this new space of conflict. We will also have elements of the strategic air forces, strategic air forces, carry the air part, as its name indicates, of nuclear deterrence, deterrence, which is a French singularity which allows us to weigh in the concert of nations, in a context where it is still relevant to be able to have your full voice. And we will have an element of air paratrooper commando number 10, so special forces too, the CPA 10. In the past, the investiture ceremony involved a trip for the newly elected President to the town hall, where there is no going up from the Champs-Elysées to the Arc du Triomphe. It is not traditional, this was the case in 1988 and 1995 as in January 1966 with General Gaulle, it is not traditional that what ceremonially consecrates the arrival of a new president to the 'Elysee, happen again when re-elected. The investiture ceremony of the President of the Fifth Republic, itself inherited from the ceremonies instituted at the beginning of the Third Republic, is indeed part of a historical continuity of which the President of the Republic is the custodian. It is for this reason that this ceremony is ritualized by a certain number of stages which are immutable. (Source Elysee).

REMARKS DELIVERED BY PRESIDENT MACRON REELECTED FOR FIVE YEARS DURING THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY

"Ladies and Gentlemen, At a time when the French are once again entrusting me with the highest office, I am aware of the gravity of the times. From the return of war in Europe to the pandemic, passing through the ecological emergency and so many crises that you have just mentioned, Mr President, at the moment of mentioning, rarely, our world and our country had not been confronted to such a combination of challenges. Where many peoples have decided to withdraw, sometimes yielding to nationalist temptation, to nostalgia for the past, to the sirens of ideologies whose shores we thought we had left in the previous century, the French people have chosen a project clear and explicit for the future. A republican and European project, a project for independence in a destabilized world, a project for scientific, social and ecological progress, a project faithful to the spirit which, since the Enlightenment, has continued to blow over our lands, turning the back with the easy demagogies. This choice is part of the history of our Republic and the presence here of my two predecessors, whom I thank for this, bears witness to this. This sovereign choice obliges me, because it is indeed the French people, the one who appoints its representatives and in particular the President of the Republic who invests me with this mandate on this day."

Yes, to act relentlessly with a goal, that of being a more independent Nation, to live better and to build our French and European responses to the challenges of our century. This action, we all know, is part of a moment in the life of our Nation where fears are there, numerous, as well as fractures.

Acting will therefore not mean administering the country, chaining reforms as we would give ready-made solutions to our people. Action, in these times, is twinned with gathering, respect, consideration, the Association of all. This is why we must all together invent a new method, far from worn-out rites and choreographies, by which we alone can build a new productive, social and ecological contract. Because gathering and pacifying cannot mean accepting to do nothing or forgetting our responsibilities. By sharing the objectives, the ambitions, the responsibilities at the national level, by having the Government, its administration, the Parliament, the social partners, the associations work together and by associating everywhere throughout the country all the active political and economic forces, social and cultural to decide and do, by planning, by reforming, by associating, I am sure that our country can at the same time decide on great national ambitions and unleash creativity and initiatives everywhere in the country. Above all, this will be the foundation of the democratic renaissance that our country needs. It will of course also be institutional and political, but it must be in action and in daily practice and everyone will have their share of responsibility.
