Jan De Volder, spokesman of the Catholic Community of Sant'Egidio coordinator of the march "Together in Peace" brought together fifty associations to give a new answer to what divides: "At the moment, it is important to stress what unites us. It should not be that anxiety prevails. We want to be together in peace, freedom and respect, and pledge to live together."

For his part, the Minister of Justice Koen Geens recalled the importance of education and quality information, "There is no better way to destroy the identities that the deformation of religious and philosophical messages ". Protesters wrapped up their march before the Brussels Palace of Justice as the Minister of Justice Koen Geens gave a speech on the occasion; another highlight of the event was a hope relayed by three young people being Muslim, Jewish message of and Catholic.-----
