GOAL REDUCING EMISSION BY 28% BY 2020

USPA NEWS - Laurent Fabius French Minister of Foreign Affairs, and COP 21's chairman, announced the publication of the USA about their contribution to the future COP21. The ambitious objective of the USA, is to reduce emission by 28% by 2025, as a first step, and then in a long-term goal by 80% or more by 2050.

The President of the COP21, M Fabius also added: This objective supports the US commitment under the presidency of Barack Obama, in the fight against climate change. It is in the context of a more ambitious long-term goal of reducing emissions by 80% or more by 2050.

After Switzerland, the European Union, Norway and Mexico, the contribution of the United States, the second largest emitter in the world, represents a new step in the preparation of the COP21 in Paris. I encourage all countries to publish as soon as possible their national contributions in accordance with the decision taken at the COP19 in Warsaw and confirmed at the COP20 in Lima.
