Opening of 4 rooms refreshed available from the passage level "heatwave alert", the following fours will be open according to the changing needs------

Established by the Regional Health Agency of Ile-de-France Regional Support Unit and Sanitary Control.

The prefect of Paris and the Prefect of Police made a call for a special effort of vigilance and assistance to his family and relatives, neighbours who may be isolated.
